

Cookie Policy - Madeira Sustainable For All

What are they?

"Cookies" are small text files with information considered relevant that the devices used for access (computers, mobile phones or portable mobile devices) load, through the internet browser, when a website is visited by the Client or User.

The use of cookies helps websites to recognise Users' and Customers' devices the next time they visit them, and in some cases, it is also essential for them to function.

How do we use them?

The sustainableforall.visitmadeira.com website uses cookies to improve the performance and browsing experience of its users, increasing, on the one hand, the speed and efficiency of response and, on the other hand, eliminating the need to repeatedly enter the same information.

The cookies used on the website only retain information related to user preferences, and no personal identifiers are registered, storing only generic information, namely the form or geographical location of access and the way they use the features of the website itself.

What type of cookies do we use?

In relation to the type of intended purposes, the website may sustainableforall.visitmadeira.com, whenever justified, use different types of cookies, according to the following specifications:



(i) Essential cookies - some cookies are essential to access specific areas of the website, allowing navigation and use of its features, such as access to secure areas, through user registration - without these cookies, the services that require it cannot be provided.

(ii) functionality cookies - functionality cookies allow the user's preferences regarding browsing on websites to be remembered, thus not requiring reconfiguration and personalisation

(iii) analytical cookies - these cookies are used to analyse how users use the online sites, allowing to highlight articles or services that may be of interest to users, monitoring the performance of the sites, as well as knowing which pages are the most popular, which method of linking between pages is most effective or to determine why some pages are receiving error messages these cookies are used only to statistical creation and analysis purposes, without ever collecting personal information.

(iv) Marketing cookies - these cookies, used to create user profiles or to track the user's navigation on this or other websites to display advertisements that are relevant and engaging to the user.

For these purposes, APM can provide a high-quality experience to its users, personalizing information and offers and identifying or correcting any possible problems that may arise in the context of their use. Regarding the type of validity, there are two types of cookies:

(i) persistent cookies – these are cookies that are stored on the devices used to access the website (computers, mobile phones, etc.), at the level of the computer application used to browse the internet (browser), and are used whenever users visit any channel again – in general, they are used to direct



navigation according to the user's interests, allowing APM to provide a more personalized service;

(ii) Session cookies - These are temporary cookies, which are generated and are only available until the session ends, since the next time the user accesses their internet browser the cookies will no longer be stored - the information obtained allows the management of sessions, identifies problems and provides a better browsing experience.

Please note, however, that by disabling cookies, you may prevent some web services from working properly, affecting, partially or totally, navigation on the website.
